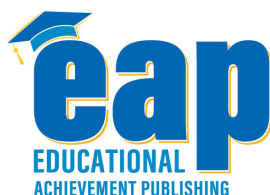

Letter Sounds Booklet

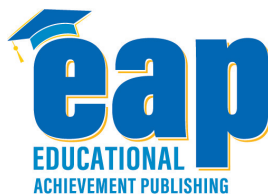
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Introduction

Letter Sounds is a 20-lesson supplement to be used with students who don't read English. This supplement does not teach word reading; it simply teaches the most frequent letter sounds for consonants and vowels. Each lesson requires less than 5 to 10 minutes. More than one lesson may be presented each day, but this schedule is not recommended if students have trouble learning the material.

If students know letter names, you may start *Letter Sounds* any time after Lesson 30. Before teaching the exercises in *Letter Sounds*, test students individually on saying all letter names and work on correcting the pronunciation of any letter names not said correctly. If students don't know letter names, delay the introduction of *Letter Sounds* until students complete Lesson 61 of DISE Level 1, by which point DISE has taught all letter names.

In some settings, non-English-speaking students are expected to learn to read immediately. This is a very insensitive plan, because students should not be expected to "read" anything they wouldn't understand if they listened to somebody else read it to them. If you are required to introduce reading before you reach Lesson 30 of DISE, you can start *Letter Sounds* earlier. For students who do not know letter names, you can first use the DISE exercises in Lessons 40–61 that teach letter names.

Follow these rules, if possible, when teaching *Letter Sounds*:

- Do not start this sequence before students pass the test at Lesson 30.
- Present the exercises in *Letter Sounds* at a time outside the periods designated for language instruction.
- Allot 10 minutes a day to work on the lessons.
- Present the exercises in the order they occur in the program.
- Do not skip exercises unless students already know the material.
- Proceed through the introduction as fast as the students are able to complete the exercises.
- Present individual turns to test mastery at the end of the exercises.
- You may teach more than one lesson a day if time permits.
- Repeat any lesson in which students have difficulty.

The Lesson Displays folder on the accompanying CD

- includes displays to show students as you present the *Letter Sounds* lessons,
- models the pronunciation of the sounds, and
- models how to pronounce letter names in two parts (which is what you do to show students which part of some letter names is the letter sound).

Conventions in DISE Letter Sounds

- UPPERCASE (e.g., F) tells you to say the letter name.
- Lowercase bold (e.g., **f**) tells you to say the letter sound.
- Lowercase bold with a breve, **ă**, tells you to say the short vowel sound, as in **and**.
- Uppercase bold with a macron, **Ā**, tells you to say the long vowel sound, as in **ate**.

EXERCISE 1 SAY THE NAME IN TWO PARTS: **F L M**

(Point to letters as students say names:) **F, L,**

Repeat step b until firm.

 - Say the letters in the word fox. (Tap.) *F, O, X.*

- a. My turn to say the names of letters: B, D, J, K, P, T, V, Z.
- Your turn: Say the names of these letters.
(Touch each letter as students say:) **B, D, J, K, P, T, V, Z**.

Repeat step a until firm.

- b. These letters are different than the letters you have worked with.
- The sound these letters make is not the last part of the letter name.
 - The sound is the first part of the letter name.
- c. Is the sound the last part of the letter name? (Tap.) **No**.
